

About the Stamps Scholarship:

In 2006, Penny and Roe Stamps created merit scholarship programs for undergraduates at their alma maters – the University of Michigan and Georgia Tech. Since then, the Stamps Scholars community has grown into a national network of visionary colleges and universities who partner with the Stamps Scholars Program to award multi-year scholarships that help driven and talented student leaders achieve their education and life goals. The program has grown to 37 colleges and universities with 2,389 current and alumni Stamps Scholars.
